Update on Feline Injection Site Sarcomas – AAHA
Initial Vaccination. (Dogs >16 Wk of Age) Administer 1 or 2 doses of a combination vaccine (see below): NOTE: Dogs residing in a HIGH-RISK environment and between 16 and 20 wk (4–5 mo) of age when presented for initial vaccination may benefit from administration of 2 doses of a combination vaccine 2 to 4 wk apart.
