Heart failure is a serious condition with poor long-term prognosis. The 5-year survival rate after hospitalization for heart failure is 60%, which is comparable to common cancers (Stewart et al). In addition, heart failure is a disabling condition with a very negative impact on quality of life.

**INTRODUCTION** — Heart failure with preserved ejection fraction (HFpEF) is a clinical syndrome in which patients have symptoms and signs of HF with normal or near normal left ventricular ejection fraction (LVEF ≥50 percent) [].Most patients with HFpEF also display normal LV volumes and evidence of diastolic dysfunction (eg, abnormal pattern of LV filling and elevated filling pressures) [].
